The Client

Airborne Labs International, Inc.

Airborne Labs International, Inc. (ALI) is an independent commercial laboratory that is ISO/IEC 17025 accredited and approved by major international bottlers. The company provides analytical testing services for customer samples, specializing in gas and fuel analysis.

The Challenge

The company ships specialized sampling equipment to customer locations on a regular basis. Before upgrading to the latest version of Wasp Asset, the team found it difficult to keep track of equipment once it left the facility. Without clear visibility into an asset's status or location, determining whether equipment was still with a customer or had already been returned often took unnecessary time.

Airborne Labs had relied on Wasp software since it began operating in the early 2000s, but its previous version had become outdated. The team wanted better visibility into its assets and a faster way to locate equipment, monitor due dates, and manage assets from a single system.

The Solution

Airborne Labs upgraded to Wasp Asset to improve its asset tracking process while continuing with a solution the team already knew well.

The shipping department uses Wasp Asset to track sampling equipment, including cylinders, Pelican cases, and laboratory analyzers as they move between the laboratory and customer sites.

Barcode scanning, check-in/check-out, and notifications have had the biggest impact on day-to-day operations, making it easier to track equipment throughout its lifecycle.

With Wasp Asset, the team can quickly look up equipment, confirm its status, monitor return dates, and generate reports to maintain accurate asset records. Keeping everything in one system gives the team immediate access to the information they need without searching through multiple records.



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The Result

Today, Airborne Labs manages more than 500 assets across two locations from a single system.

Using Wasp Asset, they confirmed the cylinders had already been checked in before their due date and quickly located them in-house, eliminating unnecessary follow-up with the customer.
